

ESSENTIAL CIVIL WAR CURRICULUM

Richard H. Holloway (Louisiana State University) is an author and historian. He was formerly a Curator with the Louisiana National Guard and University Records Manager for The George Washington University in Washington, D.C. Holloway was also an Adjunct Professor at Louisiana State University at Alexandria and Baton Rouge. While living in Liverpool, England, he gave tours of sites pertaining to the American Civil War. He published biographies of Hamilton Bee, William Boggs and Richard Taylor for *Confederate Generals of the Trans-Mississippi, Volume 3* and an essay on the Siege of Jackson, Mississippi for *Vicksburg Besieged*.
