

ESSENTIAL CIVIL WAR CURRICULUM

JARED PEATMAN (BA Gettysburg College, MA Virginia Tech, Ph.D. Texas A&M University), was the 2009 Organization of American Historians/Abraham Lincoln Bicentennial Commission Doctoral Fellow. His most recent publication is “‘Lincoln acted the clown’: Virginia’s Newspapers and the Gettysburg Address” in *Virginia at War, 1863* edited by William C. Davis and James I. Robertson, Jr., and is a small part of his larger dissertation on the legacy of the Gettysburg Address. Since 1998 Jared has given over 100 tours of the battlefield at Gettysburg, and over a dozen paper presentations on the American Civil War era and Abraham Lincoln. In 2004, while teaching seventh grade U.S. History in Danville, Virginia, he was nominated for the Virginia Social Studies Teacher of the Year Award.
